# Executive Summary

The application enables police officers who need to acquire warrants to do so through this workflow.


The Smart Warrant – Arrest & Search Warrants application has the following features:

1. Officers & Judges are users setup in the system so that they can view their own cases at any given time.
2. Officers & Judges have their signatures saved in their profiles within the database as encrypted images that can only be attached to documents by themselves.
3. Collect information from Officer
4. Upload Affidavit by the Officer
5. Generation of Warrant Document by the System
6. Officer Signature added through the System
7. Link sent to the Judge via SMS/Email
8. Judge takes video Oath of Officer\* (with recording)
9. Document Review for Approval by the Judge
10. Judge's Signatures added to the Affidavit
11. Affidavit finalized and sent to the officer as Warrant.

## STEP2: Add Signatures and Date

The system allows for the adding of a digital signature of the police officer along with the date

This Affidavit is uploaded as a .pdf into the cloud system

## STEP3: Send Request of the Warrant to the Judge

List of judges (pre-programmed) are displayed to the officer. Officer will then select the Judge he needs to send it to

A link of the Affidavit that has been uploaded will be sent to the judge via email and SMS (Email and Mobile number of the judge will be entered at the time when the Judge is uploaded into the system)

## STEP4: Judge Decision

The Judge can decide to do any of the following:

1. REJECT THE AFFIDAVIT
2. REJECT FOR EDIT

In this case the Affidavit goes back to the officer who has sent it and he may make the requisite changes and send it back to the Judge

3. APPROVE THE AFFIDAVIT

If the Judge deems that the affidavit created is correct, he clicks on the 'VIDEO CALL' button provided in the email/SMS sent to him.

He then takes the oath of the filing officer. This oath video is recorded.

The Judge then signs the affidavit and stamps the document (digitally), and also enters the date on the same

The affidavit is then converted into pdf and sent to the police officer as a warrant

## STEP5: Warrant Received


The police officer receives the warrant as .pdf

The Judge is able to view/search the following:


- Every Warrant sent through the system

## AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned Affiant who, after being by me duly sworn under oath deposes and says that **Tora, Corey Dean, White # 112019925** hereinafter styled DEFENDANT, on or about the 03/06/2024 and before the making and filing of this complaint, in the County of Denton, in the State of Texas, did then and there commit the offense of **Assault Causing Bodily Injury-Family Violence or Previous Conviction**.

Your Affiant, #19355 is a peace officer licensed by the State of Texas and employed by the City of Denton Police Department, Denton County, Texas, and has reason to believe and does believe the DEFENDANT committed the offense listed on:

Affiant's personal investigation of the alleged offense.

or

Your Affiant has read the reports filed by \_\_\_\_\_, who is licensed peace officer that is employed by City of Denton Police Department, Denton County, Texas, who presented the following facts:

On 03/06/24 I was assigned to investigate a family violence assault reported to have occurred on 03/06/24 around 19:34 hrs at 6601 Gibson Rd #118 in Denton, Texas. Officers were dispatched to a domestic disturbance at the location and contacted Crystal Jimenez. She reported that she was in the living room with her boyfriend, Corey Fox, and their 4 juvenile children. Crystal stated that Corey's daughter had slipped over the infant's railing while the infant was in it, so Crystal picked up the infant and carried her into the bedroom out of concern. Crystal said that Corey followed her into the bedroom where they began to argue. Crystal said she told Corey to leave and he began collecting his belongings. Crystal handed Corey his Playstation 5 that she had purchased for him and Corey began swinging at her multiple times with his hands. Crystal said she was not sure if he was using closed or open hands, and Corey started swinging back at Corey in defense. Corey then grabbed his property and walked out the front door. Crystal said she locked the door behind him, and she then grabbed Corey's wallet and keys he had left behind. Crystal said as she approached the front door to give Corey his things, the door burst open and hit her, causing her to fall to the floor. Crystal said Corey then picked up a broken piece of the door frame and started hitting her with it while she was on the floor. Corey then grabbed his wallet and keys and left with his daughter. Crystal had multiple visible injuries that included a small laceration under her left eye, small laceration on her left nose, small laceration on some knuckles and hands, redness and lacerations on arms, and a small laceration on her back.

On 03/06/24 I spoke with Crystal and discussed the incident with her. Crystal said she did swing back at Corey in the bedroom to defend herself, and she did kick at him near the front door when she was lying on the floor while he was hitting her with the stick. She said the stick was hitting her arms.

I reviewed Officer Gray's body cam footage where he spoke with Crystal's daughter, Katie Jimenez. Katie stated that she was in another room when the first part of this altercation occurred, but she did come out and witness Corey push Crystal to the floor and start hitting her with a board. I reviewed the photos taken by Officer Gray and observed the door frame was broken, with a longer piece resting near the door.

On 03/06/24 I spoke with Corey and asked him about the incident. Corey stated that an argument started between him and Crystal in the bedroom, and he claimed that Crystal was pushing him while telling him to leave. I asked Corey what happened to the door and he claimed that the door was already broken, but he slightly bumped it when going back in for his wallet and keys. Corey claimed that the top deadbolt lock was not engaged when he opened the door. Corey said that Crystal was near the door and fell when he came inside, and he claims that she was trying to hit him then. I confronted him about her injuries and Corey claimed all he did was hold Crystal's arms and hands to stop her from hitting him. He denied hitting her with a piece of wood from the door frame. I asked Corey if he had any visible injuries and he stated he did not. Corey sounded nervous as he spoke with me, and I believe he was minimizing what happened when explaining it to me.

I reviewed the photos taken by Officer Gray. The door frame was broken near the top deadbolt area in a manner that does appear that the deadbolt was engaged when Corey forced the door open. There were broken pieces of the doorframe and smaller debris that appeared to be from a freshly broken doorframe. Crystal told me that Corey was hitting her arms with the broken piece of wood after forcing the door open. She had redness and abrasions on her arms and hands, mainly on her left arm and hand, that appeared consistent with the manner of assault she reported.

I fully identified Corey Dean Fox WM #112019925 by TXDL, and Crystal's confirmation of Corey's TXDL photo. I believe that Corey Dean Fox, intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly caused bodily injury to Crystal, who he was in a dating relationship with and shares a child with. A review of Corey's criminal history shows him to have a previous conviction for a family violence assault.

WICREFORE, premises considered your Affiant respectfully requests a warrant be issued for the arrest of **Tora, Corey Dean White / # 112019925** to answer for the Felony offense of **Assault Causing Bodily Injury-Family Violence or Previous Conviction**.
